Attacking data entry problems

Receiving new equipment can be time consuming especially if you have thousands of items that must be manually entered into automated logistics systems like SPBS-R or ULLS.

Total Package Fielding (TPF) provides the customer a document package tailored to the STAMIS processing the receipts. For SARSS, removable media containing transactions to build the required records is included. But for SPBS-R, ULLS-G and ULLS-S4 you get paper source documents and the requirement for a time consuming, error-prone manual data entry.

Even the best soldiers in the world make data entry errors. Once committed, these erroneous records are on file. There they sit, taking



up space and creating confusion. Worse, they are difficult if not impossible to find and remove.

The good news is, it doesn't have to be that way; not with LMR's NESS program. NESS attacks the data entry problem by providing an automated means of entering new equipment data without tying the soldier to the keyboard.

NESS produces all of the data and programs required to populate SPBS-R, ULLS-G, or ULLS-S4. Your operator just loads the disk and runs the program.

The validation checks performed by NESS on NSN, UIC, DODAAC and other data fields means data entry errors are a thing of the past. With NESS, you are assured that data entry is a quick, one-time, error-free process.

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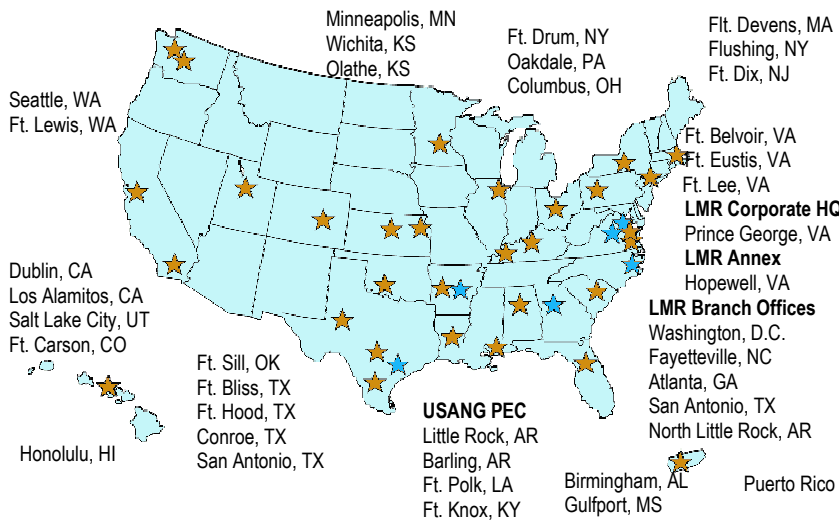
